## **Horticulture Classes Judged by Mr. Bob Oliver FNVS.**

Judged on quality and presentation. Selected on uniformity of shape and size and being of the same variety.

### **Vegetable Classes:**

1. Shallots: 6, 3cms maximum diameter.
2. Carrots: 3 cut tops cut to 7.5cms
3. Potatoes: 3 washed, same variety.
4. Beetroot: 3, round.
5. Runner Beans: 6
6. Tomatoes: 3
7. Leeks: 2
8. Marrows: 1
9. Courgettes: 2, 10-20cms long
10. Cucumbers: 1.

### **Fruit Classes:**

11. Soft Fruit: 6 on a plate.
12. Stoned Fruit: 6 on a plate.

### **Miscellaneous Classes:**

13. Curious vegetable or fruit shape: for children 16 years or under, only.

**Flowers Classes:**

14. Roses: vase of roses which can be of mixed variety. Maximum 6 blooms.
15. Sweet Peas: vase of annuals
16. Dahlias: vase of 4 mixed dahlias
17. Flowers: vase of cut flowers which can be mixed. Maximum 8 blooms.
18. Pot Plant:
  - I. Fuchsia: maximum 23cms pot diameter.
  - II. Geranium or Pelargonium: maximum 23cms pot diameter.
  - III. Foliage: maximum of 23cms pot diameter.

**Art and Design Classes Judged on creativity and execution by Mrs Jane Horton MDPF and Mr Colin Simmons FBSA:**

19. Flower Arrangement: depicting a Summer Celebration. Size: H60cm x W60cm x D60cm.
20. Country Garden on a Plate: max 30 cms diameter plate. For children 16 and under only.
21. Photograph of a plant, flower or vegetable.
22. A painting of "Plants or Wildlife in Your Garden".

**Drinks and Cookery Classes:** Judged on taste. Judge to be announced.

23. Bottle of homemade red wine: judged on taste labelled (year and type) and made from natural ingredients and not from a kit.
24. Bottle of homemade white wine: judged on taste labelled (year and type) and made from natural ingredients and not from a kit.
25. Tomato Chutney: own recipe
26. Raspberry Jam: own recipe
27. Victoria Sandwich Cake: own recipe
28. Jam Tarts: 5, own recipe.

All classes will be divided in to age groups of "16 and under" and "adult" unless stated above

Admission to the Flower and Produce Show is incorporated in the Summer Fete Entrance Fee.

Exhibit Fee per class: £1.00, but for children of "16 and under" it will be free of charge.

**Prizes:** Printed Certificates will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd and highly commended in each class.

Points will be awarded to each exhibitor at the rate of 5 for first prize, 3 for second prize, 2 for third prize and 1 for highly commended. These points will accumulate towards a prize for the overall winner of £20, £10 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and £5 for 3<sup>rd</sup> place. £10 will be given to the child of 16 years or under with the most points.

**Rules:**

1. Exhibits and completed Exhibitor Entrance Forms and the applicable fees should be submitted to the Flower and Produce Show Marquee in Stoke Lacy Churchyard on Show Day between 8am and 9.45am.
2. All exhibits must have been created or grown by the exhibitor.
3. Exhibitors may make no more than one entry per class.
4. Judging begins at 10am until approximately 12noon during which time the exhibition areas are available only to Show officials.
5. Exhibitors should leave the site after completing the Exhibit Entry process and may return when the Summer Fete opens at 12noon. Judging will begin at 12 noon.
6. The decision of a Judge will be final.
7. The PCC cannot be held responsible for damage to exhibits.
8. Prize Certificates and Prize money can be collected at 4pm.
9. Exhibits may be collected at 4pm. Exhibits not collected by 5pm may be sold for Show funds.
