June 20th - Garden visit to 3, Oakhampton Road, Stourport-On-Severn

Beginning in March 2016 the plan was to create a garden with a decidedly tropical feel to include palms from around the world, with tree ferns, bananas and many other strange and unusual plants from warmer climes that would normally be considered difficult to grow here as well as a pond and small waterfall.
Not a large garden but you'll be surprised what can be done with a small space.

July 18th - Garden Visit to 5, Beckett Drive, Northwick, Worcester

An extraordinary town garden on the northern edge of Worcester packed with different plants and year-round interest guaranteed to give visitors ideas and inspiration for their own gardens. For more than 20 years visitors have enjoyed the unique and surprising features of this garden which has many planting schemes for a variety of situations.

August 15th - Coach Trip to Claverton Manor, American Museum & Gardens, Bath

The American Museum & Gardens is located on a hilltop with spectacular views over the Limley Stoke Valley. Set in 125 acres of rolling green topography, the Grade II-listed gardens feature 2.5 acres of formal garden – one of the best gardens in the South West. The estate includes the New American Garden, the Mount Vernon Garden, and the Children's Garden, as well as an arboretum and parkland,
and our new woodland walk.
